- And more!


The Great Plains Zoo also features:



SculptureWalk is an internationally recognized exhibit of more than 50 outdoor sculptures displayed year-round in Downtown Sioux Falls. SculptureWalk adds artistic pizzazz to historic Downtown while keeping the spirit of the arts alive and vibrant in Sioux Falls.

Artists place their sculptures in the program for one year and all sculptures are available for purchase. Artists are eligible to win any of 14 awards in the Best of Show, People's Choice voting and random drawings. Awards total \$15,000 annually.

Old Courthouse Museum

The Old Courthouse Museum offers a dynamic history experience through innovative and informative exhibits, programs and special events. This beautifully restored 1800s quartzite building has three floors of regional history exhibits, historic murals, rental spaces and a museum store featuring several Dakota-made products for the whole family. See new exhibits, great live concerts, adult history programs, outreach programs, fun kids' activities and more!

Pettigrew Home and Museum

Tour the elegant 1889 Queen Anne-style home of South Dakota's first senator, R.F. Pettigrew. Take a guided tour of the historic home, or browse the museum galleries and discover the Sioux Falls of the late 1800s through artifacts, photographs, videos and more! The Pettigrew Home features detailed woodwork, gorgeous silk damask wall coverings and beautiful jeweled glass windows. The meticulous restoration of the home to its original Victorian elegance is part of the museum's ongoing mission to preserve the past for future generations.

All museums have free admission, free parking and are wheelchair accessible. Visit the Siouxland Heritage Museums, and welcome to the past!

Located in downtown Sioux Falls, the Washington Pavilion is the region's premiere entertainment, cultural and educational facility. The Husby Performing Arts Center presents a wide array of music, dance and theater, including the Pavilion Performance Series—as well as the entire season offerings of the South Dakota Symphony Orchestra among many other performances. The Kirby Science Discovery Center offers more than 80 fun and interactive science exhibits. Lift a real car with a giant lever; walk on a giant piano; pilot the space shuttle; enter the "Stairway of Sound"; touch a tornado; meet "Stan" the T-Rex and much more.

The Visual Arts Center features six galleries of changing exhibits by regional and national visual artists, with one gallery dedicated to Native American art.
